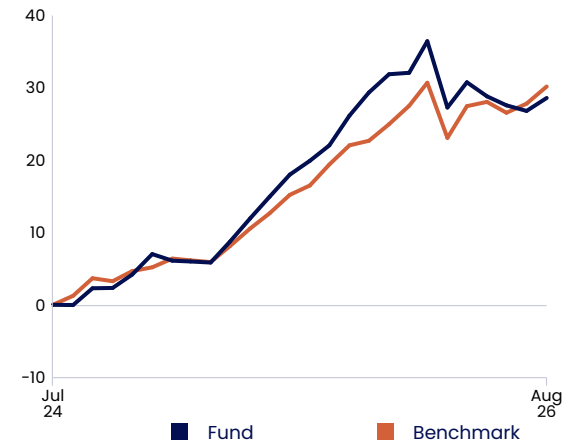

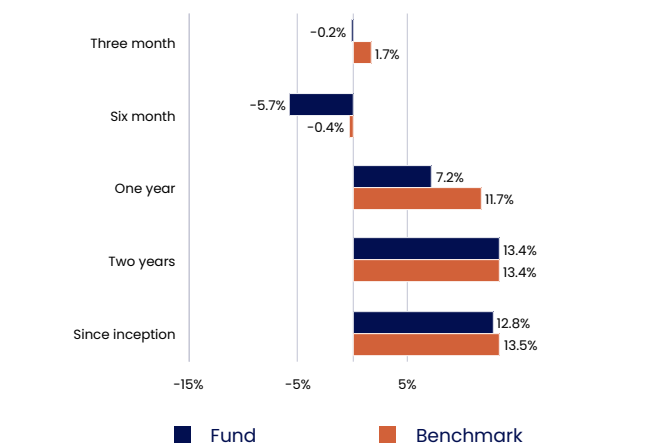

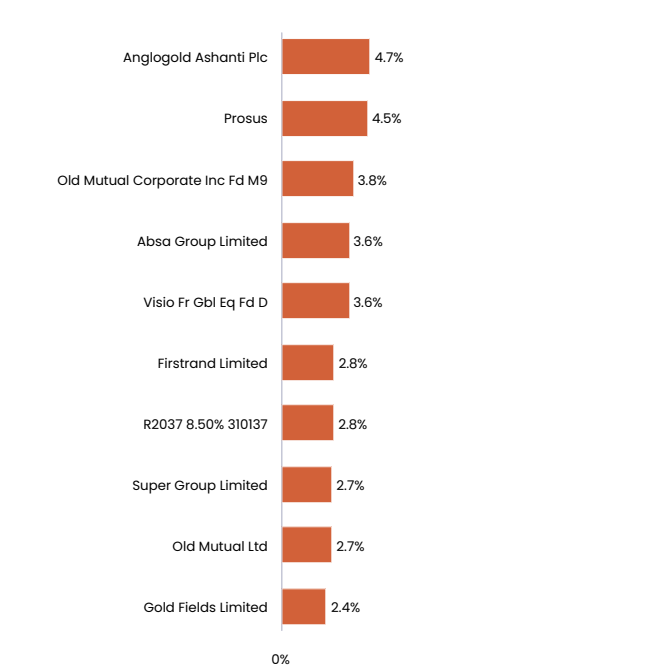

Investment philosophy

- The Curate Momentum Balanced Fund is a diversified portfolio of the best investment opportunities identified by Visio’s expert team. This includes shares, bonds, listed property and cash, both locally and offshore. Through its emphasis on thorough research, Visio aims to:

Investment policy

The fund aims for long-term capital growth with 60–75% equity and up to 25% property exposure, leading to potential short-term volatility. It invests in a mix of local and foreign securities, including money market instruments, financial instruments, and collective investment schemes across equity, bond, money, and property markets. Investments are made at fair market value, ensuring regulatory standards for investor protection.

Disclosures

Momentum Collective Investments (RF) (Pty) Ltd (the “Manager”), registration number 1987/004287/07, is authorised in terms of the Collective Investment Schemes Control Act, No. 45 of 2002 (CISCA) to administer Collective Investment Schemes (CIS) in Securities. The Manager is the manager of the Momentum Collective Investments Scheme, and Momentum Group Limited (formerly Momentum Metropolitan Holdings Ltd) is a full member of the Association for Savings and Investment SA (ASISA). Standard Bank of South Africa Limited, registration number 1962/000738/06, is the trustee of the scheme. The Curate Momentum Balanced Fund is a portfolio of the Momentum Collective Investments Scheme and Curate Investments (Pty) Ltd, registration number 2023/747232/07, an authorised financial services provider (“FSP”) under the Financial Advisory and Intermediary Services Act No. 37 of 2002 (“FAIS”), FSP number 53549, is the investment manager of this portfolio. The Curate Momentum Balanced Fund is a co-named portfolio, operating under an agreement entered into between the Manager and Curate Investments (Pty) Ltd, an authorised FSP under FAIS. A co-named portfolio is a third party named portfolio bearing the name of both the Manager and the FSP, where the FSP undertakes financial services of a discretionary nature, as contemplated in FAIS, in relation to the assets of the portfolio. The Manager retains full legal responsibility for all third party named portfolios under the Momentum Collective Investments Scheme. This information is not advice, as defined in the Financial Advisory and Intermediary Services Act (No. 37 of 2002). Please note that there may be representatives of the FSP acting under supervision. The Total Expense Ratio (“TER”) is the percentage of the net asset value of the class of the Financial Product incurred as expenses relating to the administration of the Financial Product. The disclosed TER is shown as an annual percentage based on data for the period from 02 August 2024 to 30 June 2026.
